About **TMGF Trust**

TMGF – The Mother Global Foundation Trust was formed on 22nd December, 2017 under Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950. It is a non-profit Organization led by Padmashri Dr Sou. Sindhutai Sapkal (hereinafter refer as “Maai”), the Hon’ble Founder of the trust, with her social commitments to care, protect and empower destitute and deprived members of the society with special emphasis on orphan/ destitute children and marginalized unskilled youth.

Our Organization helps to promote:

- 1** Implement and take such programs for the overall development and overall progress of the every person of various age groups in the society to make our society the ideal society in all respect.

About the Founder “Maai”

She was born on 14th November, 1948 at Pimpri Meghe village in Wardha district Maharashtra to Abhimanji Sathe, a cowherd by profession. Being an unwanted child, she was nicknamed “Chindhi” (A torn piece of cloth). Her father was keep on educating Sindhutai, much against the wishes of her mother. Abhimanji used to send her to school under the pretext of cattle grazing, where she would use leaf of ‘The Bharadi Tree’ as a slate as she could not afford a real slate because of financial reasons. Abject poverty, family responsibilities & an early marriage forced her to quit formal education after she passed 4th grade.

Life & Turning Point: From homeless Mother to a Mother of orphans

Where all the doors of family was closed for her after her marriage she started visiting various temple, travel by train begging and singing. She was often joining by other beggars and she would feed these beggars too. She wandered from one place to another begging and singing. Months and years elapsed. Life moved on. All along in the world with a baby to look after, she would sing heart rendering songs that would





fetch money for her. She had no one to look up to and she belongs to none. She entrusted her little daughter whom she named Mamata to Shri-mant Dagdushet Halwai Trust, so that she could be looked after properly. Sindhutai would work wholeheartedly for orphans and destitute, whether fortunate or less fortunate. She poured out her motherly love and affection on orphans. She took them under her wings. She gave them food and shelter in whatever way she could. Lovingly they call her AAI. Her orphans are orphans with a difference; generally orphans just keep their ward up to the 18th. Sindhutai keeps her wards till they get their jobs, get married, and settle in life. The age of inmates varied from an 8-day-old baby to a person who is in his eighties. Sindhutai's work is totally backed and funded by private donations and another help from various walks of life. The measures and travels of her own life never let her spirit down. They made her strong. Her heart-rendering speeches, her oratory, her recitals of poems and gazals are so appealing. After the struggle of years, Sindhutai is assisted by her daughter Mamata, her son Deepak, and her other grown-up sons. She has been a "MOTHER" to too many.

About the Founder “Maai”

Later Work

She has devoted her entire life for orphans. As a result, she is fondly called Maai (Mother). She has nurtured over 2100 orphaned children. As of today, she has grand family of 282 sons-in-law, 49 daughters-in-law. She still continues to fight for the next meal. Many of the children whom she adopted are well educated lawyers, lecturer, and some including her biological daughter, are running their own independent orphanages. One of her children has done Ph.D. on her life. She has been honoured with more than 800 awards for her dedication and work. She used award money by land to make a home for her orphan children. After her dedication and sacrifice at present children's have their own building at Manjari, Dist. Pune with all facilities i.e., Computer Room, Study Room, and all required facilities. Mai always trying to give standard of living to her children along with food, clothing, shelter, education and rehabilitation. At the age of 80, her husband came back to her apologetically. She accepted him as her child stating she is only a mother now! If you visit her ashram, she proudly and very affectionately introduces him as her oldest child! In person, she comes across as an unlimited source of energy and very powerful inspiration, with absolutely no negative emotions or blaming anybody. A Marathi film 'Mee Sindhutai Sapkal' released in 2010, is a biopic inspired by the true story of Sindhutai Sapkal. The film was selected for world premiere at the 54th London Film Festival.

250 Bed Residential Hostel for Orphans and Destitutes

TMGF currently operates Shree Manashanti Chhatralaya, an orphanage in Shirur, Pune taking care of more than 60 orphan and destitute children in a rented premises.

Lack of space and infrastructure has led us to undertake an initiative with the help and support of donors to develop a 250 bed residential hostel with 8 floors. The hostel will have canteen facility, sports equipments, library, computer lab, laundry facility, indoor games, gymnasium, fire extinguisher and solar water heater among other necessary facilities.

Hostel will be located at Babanrao More Nagar, Borhade Mala, Shirur, Pune. This location has good school, college and other educational institutions which will help the children in their education.

- **Orphanage for 250 Orphans and destitute childrens.**



We have been fortunate to receive a generous donation of 14,000 sq. ft. of land. Our vision is to provide a nurturing environment and better infrastructure for these children. We aim to build a **Five-story** orphanage to house these children and offer them the best facilities.

We seek your support in realising our dream of constructing a "**Happy Home for Orphans**" on this land in Shirur.

Financial contributions or donations of construction materials toward building an Orphanage for **250 orphaned and destitute children and 100 underprivileged women** would be immensely appreciated. The orphanage have canteen facility, computer lab, library, gymnasium, indoor games, solar water heater system and fire extinguisher among other necessary facilities. We will build **34,500 sq.ft.** Construction on this land. The total cost of the construction is around **7.50 crore** for this project.

Orphanage will be located at Babanrao more nagar, Borhademala, Shirur, Pune this location has good school, college, and other educational institutions which will help the children in their education.
