Dr. Sindhutai Sapkal (Maai)

The life of Sindhu Tai Sapkal exemplifies the dictum that sometimes facts are stranger than fiction. Film-maker Anant Mahadevan found this dictum true when he ventured to make a film, Mee Sindhutai Sapkal on Maai. He found her life so full of improbable incidents that he had to eschew some seemingly melodramatic incidents from her life to make the film look like a documentary of a real-life person. Just imagine a young woman of twenty, heavy in her womb, thrashed and thrown out of home by her husband in the middle of the night, giving birth to her baby in a cowshed, severing the umbilical cord herself by striking it repeatedly with a sharp-edged stone and walking away with the infant in her arms to spend the night under the starry sky. She spent her night in a crematorium to protect herself from drunkards and sexual predators.

When she felt the pangs of hunger, she picked up the flour kept as offering near the funeral pyre and baked her bread on the still burning pyre. Homeless and with a child to feed, she took to singing and begging in trains. Often, she contemplated suicide but she continued her struggle for survival. One night she alighted from a train extremely tired, and sat down in a corner when she heard an old beggar, sick and hungry, on the verge of dying, asking for water. Sindhu Tai fed him with a roti and gave him water, which saved his life. This gave her the inspiration that she could save the lives of people and be of help to the helpless and destitute. This experience changed her life and she devoted herself to the care of the helpless, destitute and orphans. The altruism in her personality became the source of strength and made her the person that we know today as Sindhu Tai Sapkal.

Social Problems we are Tackling

- Orphans face difficulty in coming back to the mainstream after leaving the orphanages due to self-doubt, lack of exposure and confidence
- Lack of educational opportunities for orphans and the very poor and backward because of acute poverty
- Constant struggle for finding food and shelter
- No or very poor medical help/ support/ care

Initiatives we have Undertaken

- Establish and operate orphanages to provide Food and Shelter for orphan children and destitutes
- Dedicated focus on education and schooling of each child
- Provide proper medical care/ help/ support at hospitals and medical centres
- Providing an atmosphere of happy home for the children to gain confidence, emotional stability and a sense of belonging



250 Bed Residential Hostel for Orphans and Destitutes

TMGF currently operates Shree Manashanti Chhatralaya, an orphanage in Shirur, Pune taking care of more than 60 orphan and destitute children in a rented premises.

Lack of space and infrastructure has led us to undertake an initiative with the help and support of donors to develop a 250 bed residential hostel with 8 floors. The hostel will have canteen facility, sports equipments, library, computer lab, laundry facility, indoor games, gymnasium, fire extinguisher and solar water heater among other necessary facilities.

Hostel will be located at Babanrao More Nagar, Borhade Mala, Shirur, Pune. This location has good school, college and other educational institutions which will help the children in their education.
